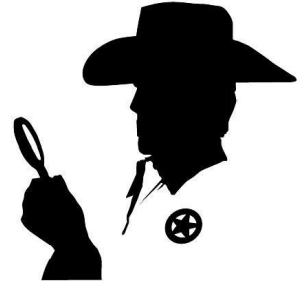

ABOUT THE COURSE

This three-day seminar is designed to provide investigators with a comprehensive overview of cold case homicide investigations. The instructors will fully explain and evaluate methodology and established protocols for not only conducting cold case investigations, but how to solve a cold case. Case studies will be used to highlight lessons learned and best investigative practices. One full day of training will be dedicated to Forensic Genealogy (interactive) and will include the introduction to Genetic Genealogy, Y-STRs for cold case work, SNPs and GEDMatch for cold case work, case studies, discussion of various tools: Ancestry, GEDMatch, DNA Painter, and step-by-step instruction for solving cold cases.

ABOUT THE INSTRUCTORS



Joe Kennedy retired from the Naval Criminal Investigative Service (NCIS) with over 25 years of service. During his lengthy career, he served in various offices around the world, including multiple deployments to Iraq, Afghanistan, and the Philippines. Joe graduated Magna Cum Laude from Pfeiffer College and obtained a Master degree from Georgetown University. Joe was the primary architect and first Program Manager for the internationally acclaimed NCIS Cold Case Homicide Unit. He wrote the methodology and protocols for the unit, which has been adopted by police agencies around the globe.



Colleen Fitzpatrick, PhD, the founder of Identifinders International LLC is widely recognized as the founder of modern Forensic Genealogy. She has worked dozens of cold case homicides for law enforcement using genetic genealogy analysis. Dr. Fitzpatrick is Co-Executive Director of the DNA Doe Project (DDP), applying autosomal SNP analysis to the identification of John and Jane Does, sometimes decades old. Her collaborations include the Phoenix Police Department, the Armed Forces DNA Identification Laboratory, the US Army Casualty and Mortuary Affairs Office, the Simon Wiesenthal Center in Jerusalem, the University of Arizona, and Harvard Medical School.

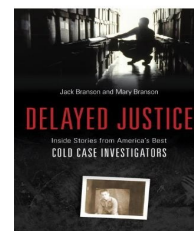
